All amateurs are invited to check-in in order of the last letter of their call signs and to remain for the roundtable afterwards.**

**This is \_\_\_\_\_ (your call) QRZ for any traffic for this net...** (pause for response, handle any traffic)

**This is \_\_\_\_\_ QRZ for any announcements...** (pause for announcements from any amateur)

**This is \_\_\_\_\_ QRZ for any mobiles...**

**This is \_\_\_\_\_ QRZ for call signs ending A-E...** (take and recognize check-ins)

**This is \_\_\_\_\_ QRZ for call signs ending F-J...** (Repeat for **K-O...P-T...U-Z...**)

**This is \_\_\_\_\_ QRZ for any call sign A-Z...** (net controls may pause near the middle of and at the end of the roundtable to take late check-ins)

The net control is then free to recognize check-ins during the roundtable in any order but generally in order of the check-ins. Mobile stations should be given priority over fixed stations and are generally allowed to comment after checking in. Some leeway should be given to new or younger amateurs. The net control is free to comment during the roundtable, take rechecks and to run the net as conditions allow.

Announcements should be repeated if possible at the end of the net.
